

BUDGET RESOLUTION 2020-141

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM ST JOHNS RIVER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT FOR THE INSTALLATION OF SUNTREE SKIMBOSS FILTRATION SYSTEMS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$324,000

WHEREAS, the St. Johns River Water Management District has awarded grant funds in the amount \$324,000 for the installation of Nutrient Removing Filtration Systems; and

WHEREAS, the project is necessary to help Ocala meet the nutrient reduction requirement of the BMAP and to restore drainage capacity in drainage retention area; and

WHEREAS, the grant is to reduce nutrient loading at Silver Springs from pollutants in surface water; and

WHEREAS, the grant funding represents \$324,000 of the total estimated cost of \$648,000.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA, duly assembled in regular session, that the FY 2020 budget be amended as outlined below to accept and appropriate \$324,000 in grant funding from the St. Johns River Water Management District and the City match of \$324,000 as outlined below:
