

BUDGET RESOLUTION 2020-175

AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FROM THE FLORIDA HOUSING COALITION FOR THE CITY OF OCALA'S STATE HOUSING INITIATIVES PARTNERSHIP (SHIP) PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$51,665

WHEREAS, the City was appropriated \$51,665 in fiscal year 2019-2020 from the State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) funding from the State of Florida to provide decent housing, create suitable living environments, and expand economic opportunities for low to moderate income persons; and

WHEREAS, on May 5, 2020 the City received SHIP funding in the amount of \$25,526 and an additional allocation of SHIP funding in the amount of \$26,139 was received on May 11, 2020. Funds were received from the Florida Housing Coalition.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA, duly assembled in regular session that the fiscal year 2019-2020 budget be amended as outlined below to appropriate \$51,665 to carry out affordable housing activities as outlined in the City's Local Housing Assistance Plan (LHAP).
