

BUDGET RESOLUTION 2020-189

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE CHALLENGE GRANT FUNDING FROM MARION COUNTY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$104,000

WHEREAS, the State of Florida, Department of Children and Families (“DCF”) contracted with Marion County to oversee the disbursement of Challenge Grant funds to further the mission of the Continuum of Care (“CoC”) to prevent and end homelessness; and

WHEREAS, the City has entered into a Sub-Grant Agreement with Marion County to administer \$104,000 of the Challenge Grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the City is the designated HMIS (Homeless Management Information System) Lead for the FL-514 Marion County CoC, it is appropriate for the City to receive the funding; and

WHEREAS, the City will receive \$52,000 per year in Challenge Grant funding for two years; and

WHEREAS, the funding will be used for the management of the HMIS Program, thus supporting the CoC’s mission to aid in the provision of services to households experiencing homelessness or at-risk of homelessness.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA, duly assembled in regular session, that the FY2020 Budget be amended as outlined below to appropriate funding as follows:
