

# BUDGET RESOLUTION 2019-109

## RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 -2019 BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE A DUI SUPPRESSION AND IMPAIRED DRIVING PROGRAM GRANT TOTALING \$25,000 FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA, FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

**WHEREAS**, the Florida Department of Transportation makes grants available to assist agencies with projects to promote DUI and Impaired Driving Enforcement and Education and has awarded funding for a DUI and Impaired Driving Program to the Ocala Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ocala Police Department recognizes the community need to reduce the number of injuries and fatalities due to impaired driving through education and enforcement, and this funding will enable these efforts program to continue; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 11, 2018, the Ocala Police Department was awarded a DUI and Impaired Driving Program Grant through the Florida Department of Transportation, State of Florida; effective October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the Florida Department of Transportation, State of Florida has allocated \$25,000 for grant activity overtime and allowable benefits.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA**, duly assembled in regular session, that the FY 2018-2019 budget be amended as outlined below to appropriate \$25,000 for Overtime salaries and benefits.
