

BUDGET RESOLUTION 2019-159

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 - 2019 BUDGET TO REDUCE GRANT FUNDING FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FP #422449-3-94-01) FOR EQUIPMENT AT THE OCALA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$24,522 AND MATCHING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6,131 FOR A TOTAL REDUCTION OF \$30,653

WHEREAS, on April 16, 2019, Resolution 2019-24 was adopted to accept grant funding from the Florida Department of Transportation to replace equipment essential to safe and efficient air traffic operations that has reached, or is nearing the end of its service life; and

WHEREAS, on April 16, 2019, Resolution 2019-142 was adopted to appropriate \$165,600 in grant funding with a City match of \$41,400 to fund the project; and

WHEREAS, due to a reduction to the scope of the project, it was determined that funds appropriated to the project exceed the requirement by \$30,653.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA, duly assembled in regular session that the FY 2018/2019 budget be amended to reduce the project appropriation as outlined below:
