

# BUDGET RESOLUTION 2019-168

## A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2018-2019 BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF PUBLIC ART IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,600

WHEREAS, displaying public art on City property for families, friends and people of all ages and backgrounds to enjoy and have access to public art enhances our quality of place; and

WHEREAS, on August 11, 2019, an anonymous philanthropist provided funding for the purchase of public art in the amount of \$25,600 to secure two public art pieces, Arabesque and Monolith Series: Shine, from the 2018-2019 Ocala Outdoor Sculpture Competition; and

WHEREAS, in keeping with the City's goal of quality of place, the City of Ocala will display the permanent collection pieces on City property in line with the City's recently adopted 10-year Community Cultural Arts Plan.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA, duly assembled in regular session that the fiscal year 2018-2019 budget be amended to accept and appropriate funding as follows:
