5 Cleaning Practices

- Pour Wash water into a utility sink or curbed cleaning facility with a floor drain. Don't pour it out into the parking lot.
- Use dry methods for spill clean-up (Sweeping, cat liter, etc.) Don't hose down spills
- Clean floor mats, filters and garbage cans in a utility sink or curbed cleaning facility with a floor drain don't wash them in a parking lot , alley , side walk or street.
- Recycle grease and oil. Don't pour it into sinks, floor drains or onto parking lot
- Keep dumpster area clean and lid closed don't over fill it .

Our actions within our water sheds have a direct impact on our rivers and streams. These best management practices help prevent pollution from going down the storm drains and into our rivers.



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
