

BUDGET RESOLUTION 2021-152

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021 BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY TO IMPROVE THE DRAINAGE AT THE HERITAGE HILLS SUBDIVISION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$608

WHEREAS, the City entered into an agreement on October 7, 2020 with the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management ("the Division") and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to improve the drainage at the Heritage Hills Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, this grant amendment is to modify the period of agreement and to increase the federal funding by \$607.50 for the maximum amount payable under the agreement to \$9,721. This agreement began on October 29, 2020 and shall end July 31, 2022, unless terminated earlier in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph (17) of the agreement; and

WHEREAS, Drainage project 1 - design for phase ,1 will help to get an approval for Phase II to upgrade the drainage retention system at Heritage Hills Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, this project is necessary to help Ocala the drainage improvement at Heritage Hills Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Division of Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency will fund an additional amount of \$607.50 amount not to exceed \$9,721, and the City will provide a match of \$3,037 which is available in the current year budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA, duly assembled in regular session that the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 budget be amended to accept and appropriate additional grant funding from the Florida Division of Emergency Management (Division) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) as outlined below:




