

BUDGET RESOLUTION 2021-174

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE E.D. CROSKY PUBLIC ART MURAL IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,000

WHEREAS, displaying public art on public property for families, friends and people of all ages and backgrounds to enjoy and have access to public art enhances our quality of place; and

WHEREAS, on January 19, 2021, Fine Arts for Ocala (FAFO) provided funds for the funding of public art in the amount of \$10,000, to secure artists Cosby Hayes and Sarah Painter, in collaboration with journalist Cynthia Graham to complete a public art mural on the West and South-facing walls of the E.D. Croskey Recreational Center; and

WHEREAS, the adopted Fiscal Year 2021 budget includes \$30,000 in funding to complete the E.D. Croskey public art mural; and

WHEREAS, in keeping with the City's goal of quality of place, the City of Ocala will display the permanent collection piece on public property at the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Recreational Complex in line with the City's adopted 10-year Community Cultural Arts Plan.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA, duly assembled in regular session that the fiscal year 2020-2021 budget be amended to appropriate funding as follows:



STAFF RECOMMENDATION (Motion Ready): Adopt Budget Resolution 2021-174 amending the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 budget to accept and appropriate funds for the E.D. Croskey public art mural in the amount of \$10,000

OCALA'S RELEVANT STRATEGIC GOALS: Quality of Place

BACKGROUND:

On January 19, 2021, Fine Arts for Ocala (FAFO) provided a sponsorship in the amount of \$10,000 that will assist with the completion of a public art mural on the west and south ends of the E.D. Croskey Recreational Center which will highlight the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Complex as a cultural asset in Ocala. The public art mural will be created by muralists, Cosby Hayes and Sara Painter, through public input regarding subject matter and incorporate an educational component that will be distributed to Marion County Public Schools. The educational piece will include the documentation of the process from input to installation by journalist Cynthia Graham and will meet Florida State teaching standards.

The adopted Fiscal Year 2021 budget includes partial funding for the E.D. Croskey public art mural. This additional sponsorship allows completion of the project.

On December 5, 2019 the Ocala Municipal Arts Commission (OMAC) approved the artist and general concept for this project.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS:

- The procurement of public art continues to enhance our quality of place and allows continued accessibility to public art throughout our community.
- The mural will become a part of the City of Ocala's permanent public art collection and will be displayed on public property within the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Recreational Complex in line with the City's recently adopted 10-year Community Cultural Arts Plan.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The City will receive \$10,000 in sponsorship to offset the cost of the E.D. Croskey Public Art Mural (001-347-000-000-02-39318) identified and will be expended in account 001-021-138-579-68-67010 which also includes the City's portion \$30,000 of funding for the project.
