

# BUDGET RESOLUTION 2022-122

## A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE 2022 LEVITT AMP OCALA MUSIC SERIES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$19,000

**WHEREAS**, the Levitt AMP Ocala Music Series provides music and art accessibility to residents and visitors alike while creating a destination where families, friends, and people of all ages and backgrounds can come together to enjoy the universal language of music and build awareness of ongoing revitalization efforts in West Ocala; and

**WHEREAS**, in September 2021, a Fiscal Year 2022 budget was approved for the City of Ocala for the continued production of the 2022 Levitt AMP Ocala Music Series in the amount of \$60,100; and

**WHEREAS**, from October 3, 2021 to November 30, 2021, sponsorship in the amount of \$19,000 were received from the following sponsors Ocala Electric Utility (\$10,000), Two Men and Truck (\$1,000), Angie Lewis State Farm (\$1,000), Wawa (\$1,000), Rasmussen University (\$1,000), Downtown Billiards (\$2,500), and T-Mobile USA (\$2,500); and

**WHEREAS**, in keeping with the City's goal of quality of place, the City of Ocala will present a free, 10-week concert series at Webb Field at the Martin Luther King, Jr. Recreational Complex on Fridays, April 22 through July 1, 2022 (excluding May 27, 2022).

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA**, duly assembled in regular session that the fiscal year 2021-2022 budget be amended to appropriate funding as follows:
