WHEREAS, on Feb. 4, 2020, the City entered an interlocal agreement with Marion County to create the Ocala/Marion County Joint Office on Homelessness; and

WHEREAS, on Feb. 4, 2020, the City entered a separate Memorandum of Understanding with FL-514 Ocala/Marion County Continuum of Care (CoC) Board for the City to assume the duties and responsibilities of the HMIS and coordinated entry system; and

WHEREAS, On April 12, 2022 Marion County issued an award letter for the City to receive Emergency Solutions Grant Corona Virus (ESG-CV) funding in the amount of \$133,539.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the purchase of this software will assist in the City's continued effort to reduce homelessness in Marion County.
