The strategies are carried out each year through an Annual Action Plan, which provides a concise summary of the actions, activities, and specific federal and non-federal resources to be used each year to address the priority needs and specific goals identified by the Consolidated Plan. The City's accomplishments and progress toward Consolidated Plan goals is reported in the Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER).
