

BUDGET RESOLUTION 2022-170

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FOR THE OCALA SEWER EXFILTRATION PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500,000

WHEREAS, the City has been awarded a grant from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection to rehabilitate its sewer infrastructure by installing specialized injection grouting and lining to degraded sewer lines and manholes to prevent the mixing of sewage flows with groundwater; and

WHEREAS, this process requires no digging and will grout, line, and seal multiple angles, and will protect the sewer system from future debris buildup, corrosion, leaks, and root intrusion; and

WHEREAS, this project will not only lead to a reduction in the amount of nitrogen loading into the Silver Springs and Rainbow Springs basins but will also lower the costs associated with the treatment of effluent at the Water Reclamation Facility and prevent sanitary sewer overflows during storm events; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection will contribute \$500,000 to this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA, duly assembled in regular session that the FY2022 budget be amended to accept and appropriate grant funding from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection as outlined below:
