

# BUDGET RESOLUTION 2022-180

## A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR ART MAINTENANCE TOTALING \$5,000

**WHEREAS**, the addition of public art to the City's Public Art Collection will further the accessibility to arts in our community and enhance the current Public Art Collection; and

**WHEREAS**, Fort King Presbyterian Church provided \$5,000 for future maintenance of *The Water and Wildlife of the Ocklawaha* mural for the next 10 years in accordance with the City of Ocala Public Art Policy Statement and Guidelines; and

**WHEREAS**, in keeping with the City's goal of being fiscally sustainable, the City of Ocala will accept the funds for future use from the Reserve for Art Maintenance account.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA**, duly assembled in regular session that the FY2022 budget be amended to appropriate funding as follows:


