WHEREAS, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. was the most important leader of the civil rights movement in the United States, and under his leadership historic reforms were made; and

WHEREAS, he was committed to his vision of a society where color did not matter; he believed his vision was important enough to die for, and he put his life on the line every day to make this great country a vibrant, multiracial nation united in justice; and

WHEREAS, he earned a Ph.D. in Theology from Boston University, and he lived his life with a moral conviction of love and peace; he preached a gospel of non-violence, and his commitment to make change through peace earned him the Nobel Peace Prize; and

WHEREAS, each year, his life, his dreams, and his achievements are commemorated in intercultural cooperation, uniting people from different cultural backgrounds on a day of celebration for all people everywhere; and

WHEREAS, we are indebted to Dr. King for the sacrifices he made; he won great victories over prejudice, and his legacy will live on and inspire generations to come.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kent Guinn, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Ocala, Florida, do hereby proclaim January 16, 2023, as
