WHEREAS, the City of Ocala and the State of Florida have designated April, historically a dry month when water demands are most acute, as Water Conservation Month to educate residents about how they can help save Florida's precious water resources; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ocala has always encouraged and supported water conservation through various educational programs and special events; and

WHEREAS, every business, industry, school and citizen can help by saving water and thus promote a healthy economy and community.

NOW, THEREFORE, I Kent Guinn, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Ocala, Florida, do hereby proclaim the month of April 2023 as

in Ocala and I call upon each resident and business to help protect our precious resource by practicing water saving measures and becoming more aware of the need to save water.
