

Proclamation

WHEREAS, The National Trust for Historic Preservation established May as Historic reservation Month in 1973 as a way to promote historic places for the purpose of instilling nation and community pride, promoting heritage tourism, and showing the social and economic benefits of historic preservation; and

WHEREAS, Historic Preservation Month can instill awareness of the local historically significant buildings and landmarks to the residents of Ocala and surrounding communities; and

WHEREAS, historic preservation is an effective tool for managing growth and sustainable development, revitalizing neighborhoods, fostering local pride, and maintaining community character while enhancing livability; and

WHEREAS, historic preservation is relevant for communities across the nation, both urban and rural, and for Americans of all ages, all walks of life and all ethnic backgrounds; and

WHEREAS, the city of Ocala is fortunate to have four registered National Historic Districts, and nine historic sites; and

WHEREAS, it is important to celebrate the role of history in our lives and the contributions made by dedicated individuals in helping to preserve the tangible aspects of the heritage that has shaped us as a people.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kent Guinn, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Ocala, Florida, do hereby proclaim May 2023 as:

Historic Preservation Month

in the City of Ocala and call upon the people of Ocala to join their fellow citizens across the United States in recognizing and participating in this special observance.
