

BUDGET RESOLUTION 2024-112

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2023-24 BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE A FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT STATE ASSISTANCE FOR A FENTANYL ERADICATION GRANT TOTALING \$25,250

WHEREAS, in 2023, the Florida Legislature established state funding under the State Assistance for Fentanyl Eradication (S.A.F.E.) program to conduct investigations designed to combat illegal fentanyl activity; and

WHEREAS, drug-related activities in the area have a significant harmful impact in the area and the Ocala Police department is committed to addressing Fentanyl issues and responding aggressively to the problem; and

WHEREAS, the Ocala Police department applied for funds through the Florida Department of Law Enforcement in the amount of \$25,250 to support overtime operations.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA, in regular session duly assembled, that the Fiscal Year 2023-24 budget be amended as outlined below.






