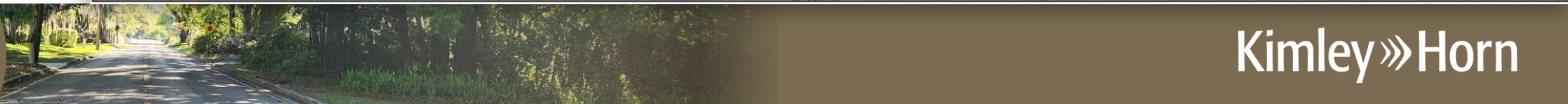
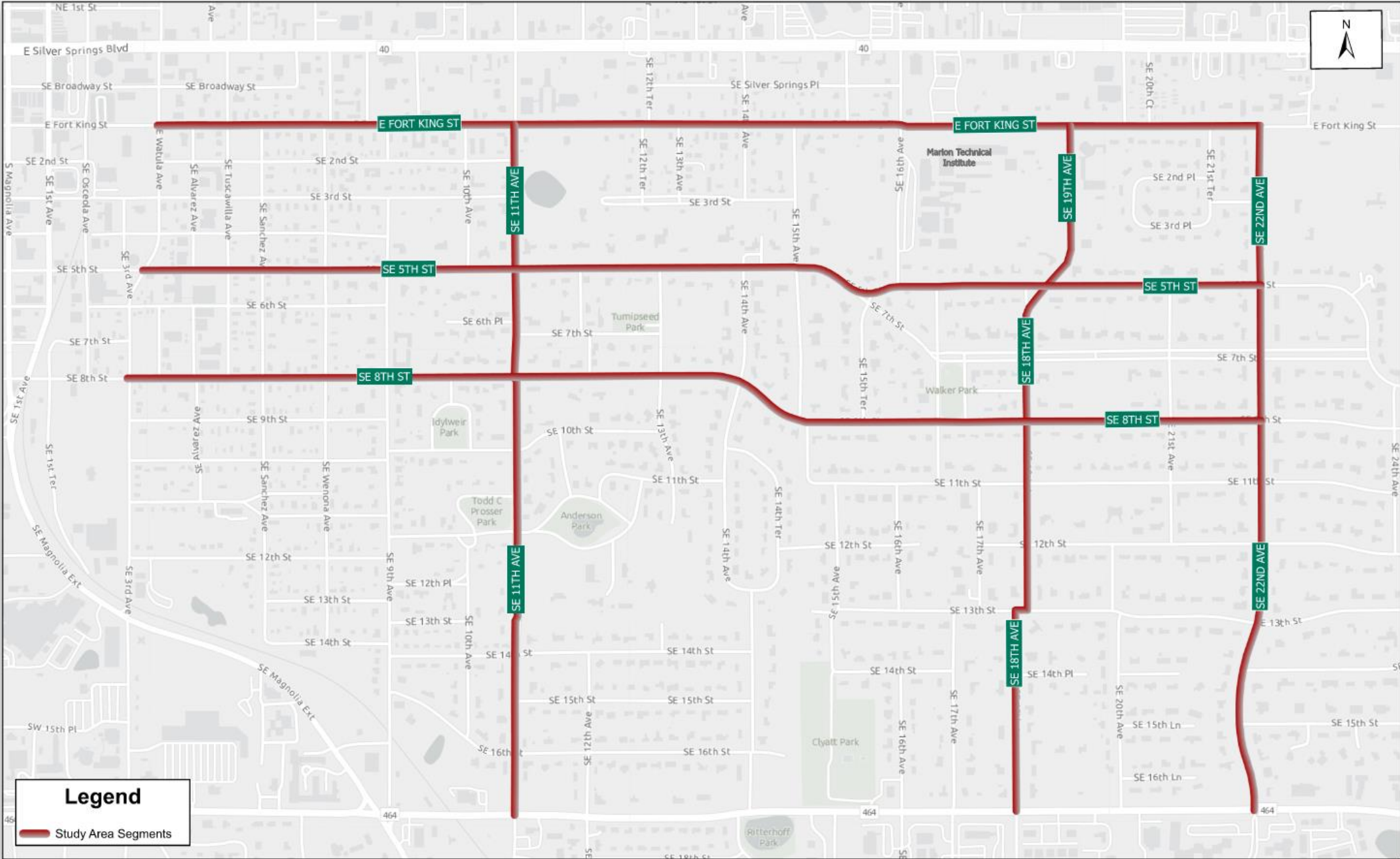

- Proximity to Schools, Parks, or other Pedestrian Generating Facilities
- Traffic Volume
