

Proclamation

WHEREAS, the citizens of Ocala, Florida, place high value on local control of community services and therefore have chosen to operate a community owned, locally controlled, not-for-profit electric utility; and

WHEREAS, Ocala Electric Utility provides reliable, efficient, and cost-effective electricity; and

WHEREAS, Ocala Electric Utility is a valuable community asset that contributes to the well-being of local citizens; and

WHEREAS, Ocala Electric Utility will continue to work to bring lower-cost, safe, reliable electricity to community homes and businesses just as it has since 1898, the year when the utility was created, to serve all the citizens of Ocala.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kent Guinn, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Ocala, Florida, do hereby proclaim October 4 - 10, 2020 as

PUBLIC POWER WEEK

to recognize Ocala Electric Utility for its contributions to the community and recognize the benefits of public power, and I urge that our community join hands with more than 2,000 other public power systems in the United States in this celebration of public power.
