A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021 BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY TO IMPROVE THE DRAINAGE OF THE 1200 BLOCK NEIGHBORHOOD AREA OF NE 17TH ROAD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$9,675

WHEREAS, the City has been awarded a grant through the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) DR-4337-479-R, as approved by the Florida Division of Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency to improve the drainage of the 1200 Block neighborhood area of NE 17th Road; and

WHEREAS, this grant addresses drainage project phase 1, which includes surveying, engineering, design, plans preparation, permitting and bidding for the proposed project for Phase II approval; and

WHEREAS, drainage project 1 - Design for phase 1 will help to get an approval for Phase II to improve the drainage of the 1200 Block neighborhood area of NE 17th Road; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Division of Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency will fund an amount not to exceed \$9,675 and the City will provide a match of \$3,225 which is available in the current year budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA, duly assembled in regular session that the FY2021 budget be amended to accept and appropriate grant funding from the Florida Division of Emergency Management (Division) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) as outlined below:
