## **BUDGET RESOLUTION 2020-101**

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020 BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE A TOURISM ENHANCEMENT GRANT FROM MARION COUNTY FOR A FIGHT FOR FREEDOM: ATTACK ON FORT KING EVENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,470

WHEREAS, A Fight For Freedom: Attack on Fort King is a four-day reenactment and living history festival that explores the Seminole Wars in Florida in the 1800's, and particularly the historic and cultural significance of the Fort King National Historic Landmark; and

WHEREAS, the event hosts 1,500 eighth graders from Marion County Schools and living history reenactors from various regions for two school days and two public days; and

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2019, the City applied for a Tourism Enhancement Grant from the Marion County Tourist Development Council for A Fight for Freedom: Attack on Fort King; and

WHEREAS, on May 9, 2019, the Marion County Board of County Commissioners approved a \$2,469.13 grant award to the City of Ocala for A Fight for Freedom: Attack on Fort King and subsequently a grant agreement was executed; and

WHEREAS, the funding will be used to advertise A Fight for Freedom: Attack on Fort King at a regional level to promote visitation to Ocala/Marion County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA, duly assembled in regular session that the fiscal year 2019-2020 budget be amended to accept and appropriate funding as follows:
