

# BUDGET RESOLUTION 2020-128

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FOR THE INSTALLATION OF SUNTREE SKIMBOSS FILTRATION SYSTEMS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$600,000

**WHEREAS**, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection has awarded grant funds in the amount \$600,000 for the installation of Suntree SkimBoss Filtration Systems; and

**WHEREAS**, the project is necessary to help Ocala meet the nutrient reduction requirement of the BMAP and to restore drainage capacity in drainage retention area; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant is to reduce nutrient loading at Silver Springs from pollutants in surface water; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant funding represents 100% of the cost of the project with no matching funds from the City.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA**, duly assembled in regular session, that the FY 2020 budget be amended as outlined below to accept and appropriate \$600,000 in grant funding from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection.
